Bourgogne-Franche-Comté is a region in France, formerly known as Burgundy. This region has a long history as a kingdom and duchy and has been important as a centre of power for centuries. Bourgogne has about 1.6 million inhabitants and is surrounded by the French landscape. A walk or car ride through this landscape will help with your immersion in French culture. Burgundy is also one of the most important wine-producing areas in France. It is known for its red and white wines, usually made from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes, although other grape varieties can also be found here. The region is divided into the Côte-d'Or, where the most expensive and most appreciated Burgundies are found. In addition, you will also find the Beaujolais, Chablis, the Côte Chalonnaise and Mâcon. The reputation and quality of the top wines, along with the fact that they are often produced in small quantities, has led to high demand and high prices, with some Burgundies among the most expensive wines in the world.

The position is offered on behalf of a regional hospital on the west coast in this region with about 1,800 employees. Furthermore, the department also has 12 musculoskeletal revalidation beds and 7 neurorehabilitation beds.

Job Description:
